Statement of Need/Course Description This course is designed to demonstrate how to accurately identify imaging findings that narrow the differential diagnosis for Thoracic, Abdominal, Musculoskeletal, Interventional/Vascular and Breast Imaging in order to ensure optimal patient care. Maintenance of certification requires continued review of essential imaging techniques in all areas of radiology. While addressing up-to-date imaging protocols in these areas, this course will cover topics including: small bowel obstruction and lessons learned from surgical correlation/follow-up, pediatric MR imaging pitfalls in the ankle, women's health in IR, breast MR/US and lung cancer screening. The course will help radiologists and clinicians optimize imaging management in terms of appropriate selection of imaging parameters, sequences and exam selection, tailored to specific diagnoses or clinical conditions.
