- *Research in Progress*: trainees each have 20 minutes to present their work in progress for feedback and discuss challenges. These sessions are opportunities to problem-solve research, mentor or curricular challenges, and help scholars maintain momentum in their projects
- *Career Crafting*: Discussions about skills including defining goals and IDP, promotion and tenure expectations, job searching, writing cover letters and personal statements, networking, giving job talks, negotiating and navigating offers, etc.
- *IDP Review*: This session discusses the process, completing, and maintaining an IDP and questions about the IDP.
- *Thematic Discussions*: These sessions will target clinical, scientific, and academic themes as determined with the trainees based on their learning needs.
