<p>Research Project Approach and Design</p> <p>The proposed research aims, strategy, methodology, and analyses are strong and appropriate to accomplish specific aims of the project. The project identifies and utilizes innovative strategies and/or activities.</p>	4
<p>Mentorship Environment</p> <p>The proposed project includes a suitable mentorship plan including faculty mentor(s) and/or team with demonstrated expertise to support the applicant’s project and appropriate engagement between the mentor(s) and mentee.</p>	1
<p>Significance and Innovation The proposed project has potential to address knowledge gaps and contribute to scientific advancement. There is also potential for products gained or applied (manuscripts, toolkits, etc.) and results that can support a strong future proposal for extramural funding.</p>	2
