**Description of the Technology**

Quikwriting is an application enabling the user to quickly enter characters into their personal digital assistant (PDA) using a simple interface that is easy to learn and use. A new but simple writing system has to be learned.

**Features and Benefits**

- Fast- The User can write continuously without having to pick up the stylus, as is the case with current personal digital assistant writing technology. The User never needs to stop moving the stylus.
- Easy- Simple interface.

**Applications**

Quikwriting is a writing system that can be used on PDA's.
