NYUPI's psychotherapy training programs are offered to clinicians who want to acquire more expertise in psychoanalytically-oriented psychotherapy. The curriculum emphasizes clinical experience, exploring how the developing individual acquires the capacity to know and care for others, attains a gender identity, develops standards and ideals, and achieves balance in working, loving and living during the life cycle. The program has three elements:

- Two years of classes, taught by the Institute Faculty (Tuesday evenings);
- Weekly individual Faculty supervision of your private psychotherapy cases; and
- Your own personal psychotherapy or psychoanalysis.
